
IMPACTED BY HURRICANE IRMA?

YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR STATE AND FEDERAL BENEFITS INCLUDING:




Disaster SNAP is now available for online pre-registration. If you aren't already enrolled in Food Stamps, you may be eligible for benefits to help you replace food.

Already have Food Stamps (SNAP)? If you live in an impacted county you should have automatically received replacement of 40% of this month's benefits. If you lost more than that, you have until Sept. 29 to submit a request with evidence of your loss.



If Irma made your primary home unlivable or you have incurred disaster related expenses not otherwise covered, you may be eligible for FEMA benefits. FEMA awards benefits on a household basis, make sure only one person applies per address. Apply online or by calling 1–800–621–3362 by Nov. 9.



Did you lose your job, or was your work or self-employment interrupted because of the hurricane? If so, you may be eligible for Disaster Unemployment Assistance. Apply by Oct. 31, 2017 online or by calling 1–800–385–3920. We have heard many reports of problems with the online system and long phone wait times, don't be discouraged! You can get free legal to make sure your application is received.
